SHOW REGULATIONS

1. The show will be held under the Licence, Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
2. The show will be held at The Chace, Cappanargid, Rathangan, Co. Kildare.
3. The entry fees will be as follows:
Special Beginners Class 1: €3.00 per dog.
All Other Classes 2 – 6: €5.00 per dog per class.
Pre Paid only Catalogue €1.00 **CAR PARK FREE**
ENTRIES TO BE RECEIVED BY: Wednesday 26th June 2013
Show Opens at 9.15 am (gates will not open before 9.00am).
4. The Border Collie Club of Ireland reserves the right to refuse any entry.
5. Dogs under 6 months of age are not eligible to enter.
6. All dogs must be registered or transferred with the I.K.C. save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club. Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event AND (b) the exhibitor being fined €127 - the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a fee of €6 refundable if the appeal is upheld.
7. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
8. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show grounds is forbidden.
10. No bitch in season is allowed on the show grounds.
11. Judges & Judging: Judging will commence at 10.00 am. In the event of any judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee of Border Collie Club of Ireland shall have the right to appoint another judge. No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or an exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication. The exhibit number for each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. Border Collie Club of Ireland shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
12. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their dog under proper control at all times.
13. The catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the committee cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes, which bring the exhibitor within the purview of the IKC Ltd., Rule 15, section 1, or for clerical errors that may occur during compilation.
14. Exhibitors must clean up if their dog fouls the grounds. Suitable facilities will be provided for this. Any exhibitor failing to clean up after their dog will be liable to a €25 fine.
15. Border Collie Club of Ireland will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
16. Ring numbers will be distributed at the show.

NOTE NEW ADDITION TO IKC RULE 7 SECTION 1.

Addition to above rule: Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- (a) the dog being disqualified from the event; and
- (b) the exhibitor being fined €127.00,
the implementation of which shall be a normal (IKC) office routine.

Please ensure that your dog is registered correctly before the day of the show and ensure that the registration number is on the entry form.

FOULING

The Owner / Handler of any dog found fouling anywhere in the venue who fail to clean up will be liable to a fine of €25.00.

PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

CONTROL OF DOGS

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times on the grounds unless in a designated exercise area or whilst competing in a ring.

No dogs to be left tied up or unsupervised.

Obedience Class Definitions

'Special' Beginners Obedience is open to all. However, prizes in this class will be confined to dogs and handlers which have not been awarded a first place in any Obedience test other than Pre Beginners or Beginners, under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club. *** See class exercises below *** Toys and food may be given during the test. Handlers are asked to please use food that does not crumble and to try to avoid food falling on the ground.

Beginners Obedience is confined to dogs and handlers which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any Obedience test or (b) 3 or more First prizes in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or (c) under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

Novice Obedience is confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) 4 or more First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners.

Class A Obedience is confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) 4 or more First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners and/or Novice.

Class B Obedience is confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) 4 First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners and/or Novice and/or Graduate (I.K.C. Class A).

Ch. Class C Obedience is open to all.

'Special' Beginners Obedience – Class exercises. TOTAL - 100 points.

1. Get the Party started Game. (20 points)

The dog can be on or off lead at handler's choice. As soon as team enter the ring, engage and play with their dog. This is to show how a handler can motivate their dog in preparation for Obedience work. Handlers may use a toy for this exercise. Play should be under the handler's control and if it involves articles they should be readily given up by the dog. Formal exercises will not be deemed as appropriate. Any form of aggression must be penalised.

2. Heel On Lead. (20 points)

This is an introduction to competitive heelwork. Heelwork on lead will include circles, with emphasis on dog/handler connection and the attitude of the dog. The handler can reward/play when he/she gets something they like at any time during heelwork. The judge would like to see at least 3 rewards. The handler should walk at a brisk pace and the dog should walk with its shoulder level with and reasonably close to the handler's leg at all times. The lead should be slack throughout. The test will start and finish with the dog sitting at the handler's side.

3. Handler examines their dog. (20 points)

The handler will show the judge how they can settle and examine their own dog - the dog to be on the lead. The dog will be required to have its mouth, teeth, throat, eyes, ears and feet examined while standing, sitting or lying down.

4. Recall to handler. (20 points)

From a Sit or Down position at handler's choice, the handler to walk away from the dog in a direction indicated by the steward until told to halt and about turn. The dog to be recalled by the handler when stationary and facing the dog. The dog should return smartly to the handler, sit in front and return to heel position – all on the instruction of the steward to the handler.

5. Stay one minute (Group exercise) (20 points)

From a Stand, Sit or Down position at handler's choice. On instruction of the judge or steward, handlers will leave their dogs in a direction indicated by the judge or steward until told to halt. Handlers may face their dogs.

*** DIRECTIONS ***

From Dublin:

Take the N7 dual carriageway, onto the M7, bypass Naas and exit at Junction 10 - Newbridge exit. At the top of the slip road turn Right signposted Rathangan. Follow this road for approx. 7 miles to a staggered junction, turn Right and then immediately Left. Carry on for approx. 2 miles to a T Junction and turn Right. Continue for ¼ mile and take the first right turn which is on a sharp bend. At this point ignore sign for Rathangan. Continue on this road for approx. 2 miles going over the canal and a small river. Just after the river you will pass a white bungalow on the right. We are the next entrance on the left – double wooden gates set back slightly from the road, and there is a letterbox on the fence.

Please do not go up the lane. We are the first property on the lane by the road.

From Rathangan Town:

In the centre of town there is a large ramp in the road. Take the turn signposted Allenwood at the ramp and continue on this road for approx 2.5 miles. You will pass Fircroft Kennels on the left. Take the next Right turn onto L7004. At this point there is a road sign pole in a triangle of grass in the road, and there is also a large house on your right at the junction which is painted green. Approx. 75 yards up this small road turn Right onto a lane. We are the first property on the lane by the road. There are double wooden gates set back slightly from the road, and there is a letterbox on the fence.

From Clane/Prosperous Road:

Stay on main road and go through Allenwood. Just the other side of Allenwood take a Left over the canal bridge, "Shee Bridge". Stay on this road for approx. 6 miles until you come to a fork in the road. At this point there is a road sign pole in a triangle of grass in the road, and there is also a large house in front of you on the corner which is painted green. At this junction keep left at the Y onto the L7004 and continue for approx. 75 yards up this small road. Turn right onto a lane. We are the first property on the lane by the road. There are double wooden gates set back slightly from the road, and there is a letterbox on the fence.
